

podrían utilizar dicho recurso. Los restantes 20, al terminar con fonema plosivo sordo (t) carecen de esta posibilidad y están condenados a ser invariables.

Obsérvese, por otro lado, que no todos los verbos monosilábicos terminados en [t] pertenecen al tipo U. Los verbos del subtipo A2, como 26-bite (y más «ortográficamente» 83-get) recurren a la alternancia vocálica.

Por otro lado, el verbo 186-read pertenece sólo gráficamente a este tipo. Es decir, no pertenece al tipo U. El punto de vista del criterio fonético sistemático que aquí utilizamos. (En la lista que sigue, los verbos se han alineado por su terminación para resaltar la coincidencia grafo-fónica.)
